Carnival: DGK Tufano called JR from the Amusement company.

- JR is not sure what's going on with any carnivals yet. Some amusement parks are being allowed to open between this coming week and July 2nd.
- They are not issuing Carnival permits yet. JR questioning the state on this since the amusement parks are being allowed to open. The state said they are looking into restrictions and recommendations for "traveling" amusement companies.
- He did make it very clear that if the state mandates him to operate amusements with a 50% capacity restriction, he will not send his company out as they will not be able to operate the ride safely and/or profitably.
- Several members voiced concerns about liability, restrictions, trying to cook and operate with masks on and open for criticism from the community.
